

## UPEACE Certificate and SAP Programmes Financial-Related Information

The purpose of this document is to ensure that applicants of the UPEACE Certificate Programmes mentioned below fully understand the tuition fees, as well as the estimated additional costs associated with their stay in Costa Rica and studies at University for Peace.

- 1. The totals shown below for tuition already include the administrative fees.
- 2. The (\$600 or \$50 USD) administrative fees are non-refundable.
- 3. Tuition should be paid in one single installment, and it is due 30 days after receiving notification of admission.
- 4. Payments can be made via wire transfer and online credit card payments.
  - 4.1. Students are responsible for all transactional/bank related fees
  - 4.2. Additional fees for credit card payments may apply
  - 4.3. Any fee deducted from the total amount paid will be reflected in students' statement of account as a pending balance payable with the next installment
- 5. Additional costs related to learning materials, accommodation, field visits, rent, food, insurance and DHL delivery of graduation documents, for example, are not included in costs for tuition and are therefore the responsibility of the student.
