#### ACADEMIC YEAR 2025 - 2026 Total Number of credits

**For Thesis Track:** 33 course credits + 8 Thesis credits = 41 credits

**For Internship Track:** 33 course credits + 8 Internship credits = 41 credits

**For Capstone Track:** 36 course credits \* + 5 Capstone credits = 41 credits
